AND COMMERCIAL
USERS: Felts introduced the ordinance establishing water rates for the City of Hinton residential users and commercial users. General discussion was held on the proposed rate. Spies inquired about the differences between the current and proposed rates, the anticipated duration of the new rate structure, and the availability of grant funding for the project. Council and staff provided general responses.

STUDY AGREEMENT: Motion by Felts to authorize the Mayor to sign the Master Agreement for Professional Services for an electric rate study, seconded by Mohning, all aye, motion carried 5-0.
